Vaccination: Allergic Reaction

Immunization represents stimulation of the immune system, an inherently inflammatory process. It's typical for some joint or muscle soreness, lethargy, or mild fever to be present for 24-48 hours. These reactions are not serious and generally go unnoticed. Pets may eat, drink, and exercise normally. An allergic reaction may be a serious event and only occurs in approximately 1 in 1000 animals. Signs that may be present include hives, swelling, or even nausea: more serious reaction can include shock or sudden death (anaphylaxis). These reactions may occur any time in the next 48 hours and may require treatment. Please contact and veterinarian immediately. PLEASE CALL 480-595-8600.
